

First Friday Scavenger Hunt Rules Friday, April 3, 2009

Registration & Check-In: (SAVE \$10 by purchasing your tickets on-line in advance)

- Teams can have up to four members.
- Teams can register on-line in advance at <http://ncartmuseum.org/buytickets.shtml> for \$20 per team (\$15 per team for NC Museum of Art Contemporaries Members).
- Teams can register the day of the scavenger hunt for \$30 per team (\$25 per team for NC Museum of Art Contemporaries Members). Payment will be accepted in cash or checks only. Make checks payable to the North Carolina Museum of Art Foundation.
- Check-in will take place in City Market located at the corner of Martin and Parham Streets in downtown Raleigh from 5 pm-6 pm. ***Clues will not be distributed until 6 pm.***
- **All teams must have one team member check-in** and pick up wrist bands for their team members.
- If your team **preregistered for the event, the teammate that purchased the ticket for the team** needs to check-in and will be asked to provide a valid photo ID (i.e. driver's license, military ID, etc.) for verification.
- Team members must stay together during the hunt.

Must Haves:

- For each clue, the team will be required to figure out both the location and an object (artwork, installation, etc.) at that location. For example, a clue may direct teams to the Downtown Raleigh Alliance office. Once there, another aspect of the clue will drive teams to find a particular object in that location.
- **Teams will be required to take a photo** of the object described by each clue using a Polaroid, digital, or phone camera. Teams must supply their own camera and cameras must have room to store up to 35 pictures. **All photos for each team must be taken on the same camera.**
- All participants must bring a valid photo ID (i.e. driver's license, military ID, etc.) for entry at the post-event celebration at Tir na nOg Irish Pub and Restaurant located at 218 S. Blount Street. ***Participants that are under 21 years of age are invited to stay at the post-event celebration until 10 pm.***

Recording and Photographing Answers

- At 6 pm all teams will be given a team sheet. The team sheet will provide clues and space for teams to record their answers. Each clue leads to a location and an object at the location. As previously stated, **teams must take a picture of the object they find at each location** and must also **record the name of the location/venue on their team sheet.**

Point Values:

- As previously mentioned, each clue leads to a location and an object at the location. All locations answered correctly are worth one point. All correct pictures of the objects associated with each venue will be worth varied points based on the distance from the check-in location. Point values will be provided the day of the event.

Transportation:

- Teams will be allowed to utilize bicycles, the Raleigh Rickshaws, Segways, the R-LINE or their own foot power to track down the clues. Cars, motorcycles, mopeds, and other motorized vehicles are not allowed. Those participants having mobility difficulties may utilize their mobility aids whether motorized or not motorized.

Disqualification:

- Any team that submits their answer sheet after 9 pm will be disqualified.

Submitting Clue Sheets

- There will be tables with event staff set up outside of Tir na nOg Irish Pub and Restaurant. Teams must submit their answer sheets to the event staff by **9 pm, or earlier**, to qualify for prizes.
- The event staff will record the time that the answer sheet was submitted based on the time displayed on the synchronized clocks at the event staff tables.
- Once an answer sheet is submitted, the team can not add or change answers.
- After the teams have submitted their answer sheets, participants are invited to Tir na nOg Irish Pub and Restaurant to listen for the announcement of the winners and celebrate! ***Participants that are under 21 years of age are invited to stay at the post-event celebration until 10 pm.***
- The event staff will calculate points based on the point value for answers provided. If your team places for a prize, your team will be asked to provide pictures of the objects you found. If the team does not have a picture of the object, no points will be awarded for the object.
- The team with the most points wins. If teams tie for points, time will be the tiebreaking factor.
